High School Sunday Night Faith Formation Options

Classes are held at 6:15-8:15pm on Sunday nights unless otherwise noted.



The **9th grade** program seeks to introduce students to discovering who they are in the eyes of God. The program addresses the questions: Who am I? Who am I to God? Who am I to the world? What does it mean to be human? What does it mean to be a much loved child of God? How does this affect my life? My relationships with God? With others? With myself? This program expands upon the ideas and concepts in Theology of the Body.



The 10th grade program introduces the students to their identity in the Church. It asks the questions: What is the Church? Who is the Church? What about my friends who are Protestant? Are we still Church? Why do Catholics do this? Why do Catholics do that? This program is more than apologetics, but seeks to bring students into a truly lived Catholic faith.



This program is designed to challenge **juniors and senior** to consciously live as a disciple of Christ through prayer and Scripture. Gathered time includes prayer experiences, breaking open the Word, and guest speakers.

This high school program is open to all high school **students 9-12th** grade. Students will look at the Scripture readings for the following week and discuss them, and from 8-9pm we will go a little deeper. and get more personal with the readings.
